	The elves march offstage. Santa looks sad

Santa 1 I'm off to bed...wake me up on boxing day (during the song the Elves 1-6 help him to bed and cover him a duvet/fetch pillow etc) **SONG 2: "SLEEP TIRED SANTA"** Sleep tired Santa, try to rest You've worked so hard this year, you've tried your best Sleep tired Santa, close your eyes Sleep through the night 'til the morning sunrise Go upstairs to bed, you know you really should A good night's sleep will make you feel so good Go upstairs to bed with a stretch and a yawn Perhaps things will seem much better in the morn Sleep tired Santa, try to rest You've worked so hard this year, you've tried your best Sleep tired Santa, close your eyes Sleep through the night 'til the morning sunrise Sleep...hush! Elf 5	How did you get that?
Elf 6	Never mind. Just make the call
	The elves go over to the side of the stage take out a phone and make the callSong/dance 3: The Spirits of Christmas starts and the spirits enter and dance.
	SONG 3: "THE SPIRITS OF CHRISTMAS"

	Song ends and the spirits move to the front of the stage to speak
Spirit 1 and 2	Your wish is kind, your hearts are pure We'll grant your wish, if you are sure
Spirit 3 and 4	That Santa really knows his mind 'Cos with more Santas, he might find
Spirit 5 and 6	One Father Christmas is enough And life might soon get very tough
	The spirits waves their wands and there is a magical sound. The spirit leaves the stage. Santa 2 enters the stage. He looks cross
Santa 2	What's all this noise about? I'm trying to sleep.
	Suddenly, there is a magical sound and one after another the four European Santa's enter the stagefrom Spain (El Niño Jesus), Germany (der Wehrnachtsmann), Sweden (Tomte) and Italy (Babbo Natale). Santa looks confused.
Santa 2	What is the meaning of this? Who are you all?
	Each of the Santa introduce themselves in turn
El Niño	I am El Nino Jesu: from Spain, and I am the best Santa (bows)
Weihnachtsmann	I am der Weihnachtsmann: from Germany, and I am the best Santa. (bows)
Tomte	I am Tomte: from Sweden, and I am the best Santa. (bows)
Babbo Natale	I am Babbo Natale: from Italy, and I am the best Santa. (bows)
Santa 2	But why are you here?
El Niño	We are all part of you
Weihnachtsmann	The Christmas spirits split you up
Tomte	You wished for more Santas and here we are
Babbo Natale	We're here to help you with the elves. But first we must sort out who is the best Santa
	The Santas group together and start to argue
Santa 2	(looking at elves) Did you elves have anything to do with this?
Elf 1 and 2	Eryessorry Santa
Elf 3 and 4	We were only trying to help

Santa	But you've just made it worse. They're all just arguing with each other! YOU'LL have to find the Christmas Spirits and get them to sort this out.
Elf 5 and 6	Let's phone them again
	The elves use the phone to ring. There is a pause and the spirits appear on stage.

	Everyone leaves the stage and Scene ends

SCENE 3	Back inside Santa's workshop. Santa 2 enters and sits on his chair at the back of the stage
Narrator 3	While the Elves looked for Christmas spirit, the new Santas told everyone about celebrations in their own countries
Santa 2	Ok, let's hear about Christmas in Spain and Germany then!
	Spanish dancers come out and song starts. El Niño Jesus first:

	Who'd be a woodland creature? You'll find it soon would teach ya How running fast, means you survive! We spend the Winter waiting Freezing cold, just hibernating Working hard to stay alive So don't come here looking for Christmas Spirit! You've come here causing lots of fuss
•	Cos no one in the woods has time for festive feelings Please walk away, don't bother us!
	Song ends and Elves gather round the animals
